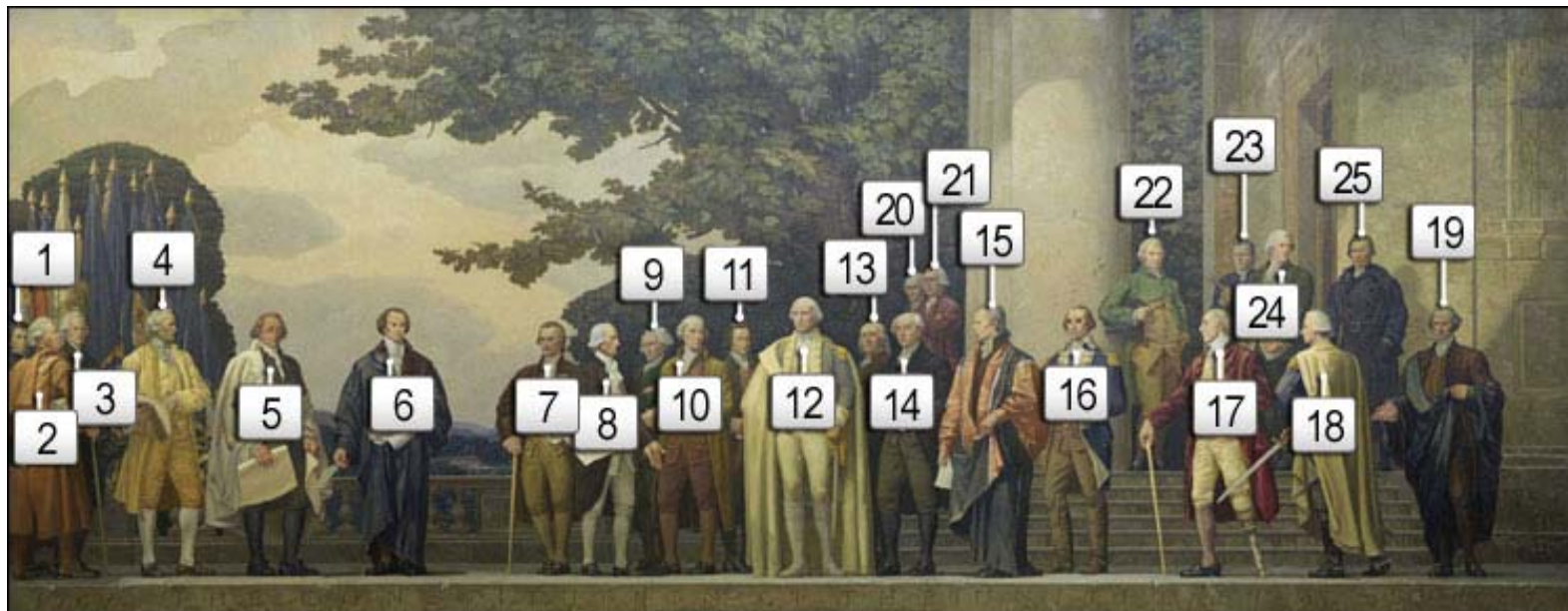


Activity Two: Comparing Christy and Faulkner and the Constitution
